

Building Design

- Differing cladding materials to add visual interest and break up the visual building massing
- Utilise curved roof forms to reduce the perceived height of the building, whilst providing clear lines to distinguish the form
- Use of feature cladding to accentuate the form of the facility
- Varied use of elevational treatment to identify key areas and uses (i.e. office entrance)
- The use of glazing to add transparency to the façade, to offer some form of natural surveillance and visual interest
- All new employment buildings will be constructed to net zero carbon in construction in line with the UK Green Building Council's (UKGBC) Net Zero Carbon Buildings Framework'
